PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m.

Atty. Don H. Culvera, Chairperson of the Bids and Awards Committee presided the meeting. The Secretariat recorded the minutes thereof.

Engr. Almirante A. Abad, Head, Secretariat made the roll call and informed the Chairperson that four (4) out of five (5) Members of the Bids and Awards Committee were present, hence, there was a quorum.

Item No. 7. Business of the Day

a. Pre-bid Conference for the following:

a.1 PR No. 21010127 – Supply and Delivery of T-shirt & other

Atty. Don H. Culvera inquired if there were prospective bidder/s for the aforesaid Purchase Request and Ms. Jenilyn P. Alpechen, Representative of Cotton City Marketing, Legaspi City signified her intention to bid for the said PR. Atty. Culvera requested Ms. Joy Lourice T. Roderno, Member, TWG to explain the requirements, terms and conditions stipulated in the bidding documents, eligibility requirements and the technical and financial components of the said Purchase Request.

Ms. Roderno clarified and explained the following requirements, terms and conditions stipulated in the Invitation to Bid for Purchase Request No. 21010127 – Supply and Delivery of T-shirt & other, viz:

1. The Provincial Government of Camarines Norte through the General Fund CY 2021 intends to apply the sum of Three Million Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P3,350,000.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for Purchase Request No. 21010127 – Supply and Delivery of T-shirt & other. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The Provincial Government of Camarines Norte now invites bids for T-shirt & other.

Delivery of goods is required within 60 calendar days. Bidders should have completed, within 5 years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instruction to Bidders.

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

4. Bidders may obtain further information from the Provincial Government of Camarines Norte and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address indicated in the ITB from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.
5. The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees in person.

7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the address indicated in the ITB on or before February 16, 2021, 1:30 p.m. Late bids shall not be accepted.
8. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 14.
9. Bid opening shall be on February 16, 2021, 2:00 p.m. at Bids and Awards Committee Office, 2nd Floor, Provincial Capitol Building, Daet, Camarines Norte. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidder's representatives who choose to attend the activity.
10. The Provincial Government of Camarines Norte reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35 and 41 of the revised IRR of RA 9184 without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

 - Mayor's permit from principal place of business
 - Statement of all ongoing and completed contracts/projects including awarded but not yet started (supported by documents, such as notice of award, contract, notice to proceed and Certificate of Acceptance and Completion)
 - Tax Clearance per Executive Order 398, Series of 2005, as finally reviewed and approved by the BIR
 - Audited Financial Statement stamped "received" by the BIR
 - NFCC Computation at least equal to ABC or Credit Line Commitment from a universal or commercial bank (10% of ABC)
 - Valid Joint Venture Agreement (JVA) in the case joint venture is already existing. In the absence of JVA duly notarized statements from all potential joint venture partners that they will enter into and abide by the provision of the JVA (if applicable)
 - PhilGEPS Registration Certificate
2. Bid Security
3. Technical Specifications
4. Omnibus Sworn Statement
5. Other documents

Ms. Roderno reminded the prospective bidder that all licenses must be updated and the bidding documents of the aforementioned Purchase Request is already uploaded in the PhilGEPS and can be downloaded by the interested bidder/s.

Ms. Jenilyn P. Alpechen, Representative of Cotton City Marketing, Legaspi City asked about the number of copies required in the submission of bids to which Ms. Roderno replied one (1) original copy and two (2) duplicate copies and placed in one (1) envelope.

a.2 PR No. 21010128 – Supply and Delivery of Plastic bag with Print

Atty. Don H. Culvera inquired if there were prospective bidder/s for the aforesaid Purchase Request and there was none. Nonetheless, Atty. Culvera requested Ms. Joy Lourice T. Roderno, Member, TWG to explain the requirements, terms and conditions stipulated in the bidding documents, eligibility requirements and the technical and financial components of the said Purchase Request.

Ms. Roderno clarified and explained the following requirements, terms and conditions stipulated in the Invitation to Bid for PR No. 21010128 – Supply and Delivery of Plastic bag with Print, viz:

1. The Provincial Government of Camarines Norte through the General Fund CY 2021 intends to apply the sum of Two Million One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P2,100,000.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for Purchase Request No. 21010128 – Supply and Delivery of Plastic bag with Print. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The Provincial Government of Camarines Norte now invites bids for Plastic Bag with Print.
Delivery of goods is required within 60 calendar days. Bidders should have completed, within 5 years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instruction to Bidders.
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The Provincial Government of Camarines Norte now invites bids for Sound System.

Delivery of goods is required within 60 calendar days. Bidders should have completed, within 5 years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instruction to Bidders.

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules


